
**Antonios A. Nestoras** is adjunct professor of international affairs at the Vesalius College and a researcher at the Institute for European Studies of Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB). He also contributes regularly in the work of the Institute of European Democrats. His research focuses on European politics, foreign and security policy and geopolitics. In the past, he has served as policy advisor in the ALDE Group and as parliamentary assistant to Members of the European Parliament. He has also held positions with the EPP Group and the Wilfried Martens Centre for European Studies. His doctoral thesis in the VUB examines the historical development of geopolitical narratives and their influence on foreign policy. He is a laureate of the Huygens Scholarship for International Talent.

**Francisco Aldecoa Luzárraga** is the Professor of International Relations at the University Complutense of Madrid. Prior to that he was the Professor at the University of the Basque Country. He is the Vice-President of the Spanish Federal Council of the European Movement and the member of the Executive Committee of the Movement for Peace, Disarmament and Liberty (MPDL). Since 1993, he holds the Jean Monnet Chair ad personam of the European Commission. In past, he was the Dean of the Faculty of Political Sciences and Sociology at the University Complutense of Madrid, the Vice-Chancellor of the University of the Basque Country and the President of the Spanish Association of Professors of International Law and International Relations (AEPDIRI). In his research work, he focuses on the European integration, European enlargement, European Foreign Policy and on the relations between the EU and Latin America.

**Michael Keating** is the Professor of Politics at the University of Aberdeen and the University of Edinburgh and the Director of the ESRC Centre on Constitutional Change. He was previously Professor of Political Science at the University of Essex, North Staffordshire Polytechnic, University of Western Ontario, University of Strathclyde and the European University Institute in Florence. He has been visiting professor in the USA, Spain, France, Australia and England. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Edinburgh, Fellow of the British Academy, Fellow of the Academy of the Social Sciences and Member of the European Academy. From 2010 until 2013 he was an ESRC Professorial Fellow and in 2013-14 was ESRC Senior Fellow on the Future of the UK and Scotland programme. During 2015-16 he is Senior Fellow in the ESRC UK in a Changing Europe programme. He specializes in nationalism, European and regional politics and devolution.
