Yiorgos Lillikas is a Cypriot politician and the President of the Citizens' Alliance. He previously served as the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Cyprus (2006-2007) and the Minister of Commerce, Industry, and Tourism of Cyprus (2003-2006). He also acted as the government's spokesman. Before, he was the Member of the House of Representatives of Cyprus, member of the Parliamentary Committees on Finance, Foreign and European Affairs, Education, and Trade and he chaired the Parliamentary Committee on the Environment. In past, he acted as the Head of the Cyprus Parliamentarian Delegation to the Parliamentary Assembly of the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE) and the Vice President of the Committee of Political Affairs and Security. He studied Political Science at the Institute of Political Science in Lyon and Grenoble (France).

Kostas Chrysogonos is the Member of the European Parliament representing the Greek SYRIZA party. He is full member of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Committee on Constitutional Affairs of the European Parliament. He is Professor of Constitutional law at the Law Faculty of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (Greece). He delivered lectures in Constitutional Law at the National Academy of Judges and the Hellenic Open University (Greece) and as a Visiting Professor at the University of Regensburg and University of Hanover (Germany). He is the author of numerous publications dedicated to Constitutional law and Human Rights. He studied law at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and Leibniz University in Hanover.





Andreas S. Angelides is a former Member of the Parliament of the Republic of Cyprus and Parliamentary Party Spokesperson. He has obtained a Law degree from the University of Athens (Greece) in 1969 and a subsequent degree in Political and Economic Sciences from the University of Athens in 1975. He is the Founder and C.E.O of Andreas S. Angelides LLC and a practicing lawyer since 1971, with a specialisation *inter alia* in administrative, constitutional, human rights, public, employment law and tenders. He is a member of the Cyprus Bar Association and was the Vice-President of the Cyprus Human Rights' Association and President of Cyprus Young Scientists Association. He is the author of numerous publications, books and articles dedicated mainly to the Cyprus Problem, Human Rights and Constitutional Law.

George M. Pikis is a Cypriot judge, former President of the Supreme Court of Cyprus and former Judge of the International Criminal Court in Hague (Netherlands). He also served as an ad hoc judge of the European Court of Human Rights and as a member of the United Nations Committee against Torture. He devoted his entire professional career to law, starting as the judge and President of the Regional Court in Cyprus (1972-1981), judge and President of the Supreme Court of Cyprus (1981-1995), and later becoming Judge of the International Criminal Court (2003-2009). He is the author of numerous publications dedicated to international criminal law and he is one of the top experts on criminal law in Europe. He studied Law at the University of London (United Kingdom).



Luca Bader is the Chief Executive Officer and Director of the Institute of European Democrats (IED). He is also the Chief of Staff of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Italy. In past, he served as the responsible for Europe and North America at the Democratic Party in Italy, Advisor of the Committees of Foreign Affairs and Defence of the Italian Parliament and Advisor in the European Parliament in Brussels (Belgium). He worked for the National Democratic Institute of Washington D.C. (USA), advising the program on building institutions and political parties. He studied International Relations at the London School of Economics and University of London (United Kingdom), and he did research at the Columbia University in New York (USA) and the Institute of International Affairs in Rome (Italy).

Andrzej Potocki is the Vice-President of the Polish political party Stronnictwo Demokratyczne and Vice-President of the Parti Démocrate Européen-European Democratic Party (PDE-EDP), member of ALDE Group of the European Parliament. He is also the coordinator of the opposition coalition KOD (Committee for the Defence of Democracy) against the current Polish ruling party. He began political activity in the Polish Solidarity movement and he was among the founder members of the Civic Movement Democratic Action (ROAD). He was the associate of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) and the member, political officer and acting chairman of the numerous OSCE observation missions in Balkans. He graduated from the Catholic University of Lublin (Poland).
