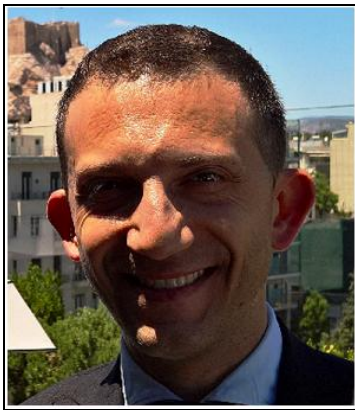
SPEAKERS



Antonella Mularoni is the former Minister of Territory and Environment, Agriculture, Telecommunications and International Economic Cooperation of the Republic of San Marino. She is the member of the Scientific Committee of the Institute of European Democrats. She served as the Captain Regent of San Marino from April 2013 to October 2013 and Secretary for Foreign Affairs from December 2008 to December 2012. She also acted as the Sammarinese judge for the European Court of Human Rights in Strasbourg, France. She graduated in the law studies from Bologna University in Italy.

Luca Bader is the Chief Executive Officer and Director of the Institute of European Democrats, political and research institute formally recognised by the European Parliament. He is also the Chief of Staff of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Italy. In past, he served as the responsible for Europe and North America at the Democratic Party in Italy, Advisor of the Committees of Foreign Affairs and Defence of the Italian Parliament and Advisor at the European Parliament in Brussels, Belgium. He graduated from the London School of Economics and University of London in the United Kingdom.

He graduated from ITIS Leonardo da Vinci di Rimini, Italy.

He was educated as a Management Engineer and began his career in Sony Broadcast Italy.
