Personal profile statement

I was born in 1972, in Kyrenia, a historic small town in the Northern Cyprus. In 1974 the Turkish troops invaded Cyprus and occupied my home city and we were forced to leave our homes becoming thus, refugees. Being a member of a family, which has tragic memories from the Turkish invasion of 1974, we had 7 family members missing, as a result of the invasion, one of them is my Father. All the family missing persons together with other village neighbors were found and identified -by DNA method- only in year 2008, in a common grave near our village, the youngest being only 14 years and the oldest being 78 years old.

Our village, Elia, is situated next to the shore where the Turkish troops invaded in 1974.

I am the daughter of Charita Mantoles, a "symbol" of the long struggle of the relatives of missing persons and I carry on my shoulders a legacy of pain and responsibility for the continuation of our struggle for justice and freedom in Cyprus.

As a woman, I struggle through many positions for women's rights including the right to live free from violence, slavery, and discrimination;

In addition to my involvement in education, i am struggling for the liberation of my country and the identification of the fate of all missing persons, through my participation in various refugees' associations and organizations.
