Working and political experiences since 1970

Politics

1986-1994 Member of (the second chamber of) parliament for the Labor Party and the spokesman (shadow secretary) on health care (besides hospitals, public health etc.), health insurance, public financing and restructuring. Spokesman on tax-issues.

Among other parliamentarian functions vice-chairman of the committee of the parliament for disabled people.

2019-2021 Member of parliament for the 50PLUSparty the spokesman amongst others on (public) finance taxes, economic affairs and climate change, foreign (EU) and internal affairs, housing. Member of the special comity on digitalization.

In each period in parliament I successfully had a proposal for an initiative law which were accepted by both houses of parliament.

The "Van Otterloo law" in 1994 meant changes in the way of health insurance was accessible for those over 65 with no jobs or self-employed before retirement age. Between 200.000 and 300.000 people benefitted from these changes. This law also changed the definition of income and regulations for the pensioners.

Chairman of the HSHB (a humanistic charity on financing initiatives for housing and social support for the elderly)

Chairman of the commission for legal status of retired politicians (merely focusing on pensions and giving on request advice to the government on proposals for new laws.

Treasurer at the board of the foundation FREEHOUSE (projects combining art and social development)

Member of the controlling board at a corporation for social inventions on the south bank in Rotterdam
